II: Other Rooms in Coe Hall

A) Dining Room: Court Cupboard, inscribed at top, front, "WMB 1672"

- 1) Piece now stands in approximately original position in dining room.
- 2) For a time Marquerite Pettet had it in her office in New York City. (She was 10 years at 47th Street, 10 years at 57th Street, To Coe Hall 1974).
- 3) M. P. sold off about 6-8 court cupboards from Coe Hall.

B) Living Room: Van Dyke Paintings

- 1) Hung in same position as in H/H photos.

C) Large Front (Entrance) Hall: Frank Salisbury-Portrait of WRC, 1930's

- 1) Robert Coe letter, 12/21/65, mentions this portrait as hanging in present spot over fireplace.

D) Front Hall: Metal Urn (in front of French Room)

- 1) M.P. had it in her New York City office for a time.

E) Gallery: Weesop Portrait of Lenthall Family

- 1) Still hangs in gallery

F) French Room: Chair with ottoman

- 1) Originally in gallery with a mate.
- 2) In M. P.'s home for a time
- 3) Recently reupholstered by William Klein of Sears, Roebuck.
