### Two Rare Castelli Tin-Glazed Earthenware Spouted Wet Drug Jars

Two rare *Castelli* tin-glazed Renaissance earthenware spouted wet drug jars, of *Orsini-Colonna* type, c. 1520, each having dragon head and neck spout, applied side handle, each finely decorated with two profile bust-portraits, facing each other on either side of the spout, one showing the portrait of two young men, one, showing the portrait of two grey-haired old men, each with Gothic printing below in Latin,

the jar with the young men, titled:

*Syrup of Byzantium* (translated from the Latin)

the jar with the old men, titled:

*Syrup of Roses* (translated from the Latin)

each with old damage and repair.
