Silk (?) runner of deep blue background with a border of floral motifs and  
ladies with parasols and strolling by pagodas.      1994.020.001

Wool runner                      46" x 15 1/2"  
Wool runner fringed at ends and bordered in vegetal pattern of blue and  
copper. Center field is off-white with pattern of ladies with lyres, antelopes,  
and fruit trees.

Twelve sided tray with raised gallery ( 1/2" high) with circular dragon motif and central design of Chinese characters.
