Two chairs, each appearing to be William & Mary chairs, c.1670-1700, however, each with substantial restoration:

a. a William & Mary "Great" chair, oak, painted black, having ornately carved back with crown and scroll motif, over a central caned section, with crown and scroll-carved surround, the side stiles blocked and spiral turned, the arm rests having foliate carving, supported by spiral carved and blocked stiles continuing to legs, cross-hatched design on seat rails, caned seat over bold, ornately carved front stretcher, also with crown and scroll motif, "H"-stretchered base with block and spiral turned motif, (all the feet have been "ended-out").
