Queen Anne Style Mirror

A late 19th- early 20th century Queen Anne style walnut and gilt wall mirror, having a heavily gilded, foliate and floral carved and pierced demilune crested pediment centered by swirls of faux initials, over deeply molded straight-edge walnut frame surround, warm, rich patina to wood. The pierced carving of the pediment is very well done.
