I have valued the Appraised at 50% higher than the Comparable. The Appraised is made by Tiffany & Co., the premier manufacturer of silver at the time this was purchased.

Also, a silver tea-coffee service is probably the quintessential household artifact, connected with the social life of a family, with friends, and also amongst themselves. Having this item, with its immediate and direct connection to the Coe family and the Planting Fields home is of the utmost importance to the Foundation and is valued as such.
