


Bishop's Room

Bishop's Room Beds, Dressing Table, Chest of Drawers

William Clark: Did no work on the beds.

The "oyster veneered" chest replaced missing veneers and reset lifted veneers. Touched up finish.

The Queen Anne dressing table also had repairs done to the veneers and was refinished. Note the dressing table has a lift top and the drawers are false fronts. Apparently it was modified for use as a sewing table.
