I hope, as does Mrs. Montgomery, that the springs be omitted in the re-upholstering. The webbing should be on top of the seat rails.

I hope to be able to remove most of the green antiquing off the upper sections of the vitrines and to re-gesso and re-guild the bases. I anticipate about \$ 2,000.00 more expense including delivery back to Coe Hall.

In addition to the balance due at this time I would appreciate an extra \$ 500.00 to cover the gold leaf material expense.
