MEMORANDUM TO FILES

Re: Planting Fields Foundation Property Located
at the Home of Robert Coe Located in Cannes,
France, formerly Located at the House of W.
R. Coe at Planting Fields

Today is October 19, 1980 and I am in the presence of Robert Coe dictating into this memorandum the items which are contained in his house. They are as follows:

1. Statue of Eros by a Belgian sculptor called Godecharle which was formerly located in the Court Yard. The statute dates from the early 1800's.
2. Twelve occasional Portuguese hand-carved chairs, without arms, and low backs.
3. Painting by Sartorius entitled Hunting Scene. This painting was formerly located in the office of Gordon Jones and at Robert Coe's request it was sent to him in France and he in turned loaned it to Natalie for use in her home which he is presently renting in France.
4. Mantel located in Robert Coe's library formerly located in W. R. Coe's original bedroom.
5. Chandler murals presently located in Robert Coe's dining room which were located originally in Mrs. Coe's bedroom at Planting Fields.
6. A second mantel piece located in Robert Coe's bedroom in Cannes which was formerly in Henry's bedroom.
7. Two needlepoint sofas presently in the Salon in Robert Coe's house. Mr. Coe does not recall where they were located at Planting Fields.
8. Painting of H. H. Rogers located in the Salon at Mr. Coe's home formerly located in the living room at Planting Fields.
