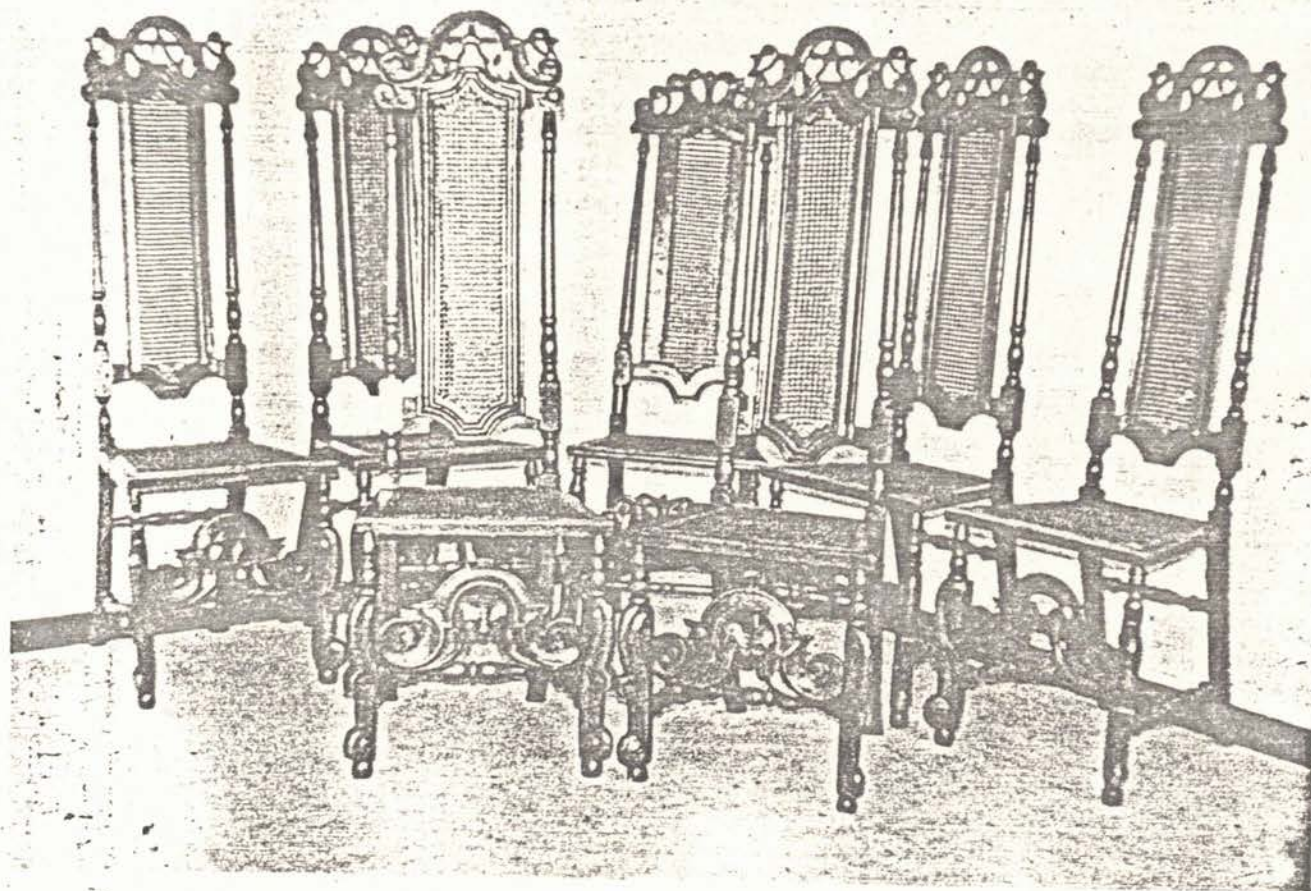

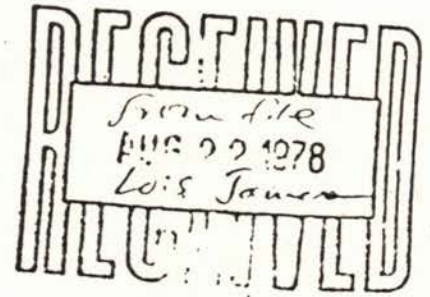


**SET OF SEVEN STUART CARVED WALNUT
