Dear Mr. Coe:

On behalf of the Planting Fields Foundation, I wish to thank you for the following gifts:

One bureau measuring 37" x 22" x34 ½" and veneered in burled walnut. The piece has three full drawers and two half-sized drawers nesting side by side. The top of the bureau is inlayed in a pattern of semi-circles. The entire piece rests on bun feet. Small sections of inlay are missing, as is a piece of moulding from the lower portion of a side façade. The piece is European and dates from the 18th century.

One compote dish measuring 9" in diameter by 6 3/4" in height and marked "Howard & Co. New York Sterling 1886." The bowl portion is decorated with a patterned band of flowers in relief and the base is enriched with a raised pattern of classical motifs. The piece is American and dates from the late 19th century.

The pieces will be used to continue the mission of the Planting Fields Foundation to restore and interpret Coe Hall to the public.
