ARTIST — Bob Scriver

More than a decade ago, the first Scriver bronze was cast. Since then, the talent and zeal of Robert Macfie Scriver has enabled him to move to the forefront of contemporary sculptors.

Scriver is known for the research and discipline which provide the backbone of each of his works. The result is a creation that is superbly detailed, with an accuracy that is not bound to static, frozen detail.

Scriver is a member of the Cowboy Artists of America, National Society of Western Art, Salamagundi Club, National Sculpture Society, National Art Guild, and Society of Animal Artists. He has successfully completed heroic size bronzes of Bill Linderman for the Cowboy Hall and of Lewis and Clark for Fort Benton, Montana.
