

CONSERVATION/RESTORATEON

- 1. Transport 3 side chairs, one couch, 2 vitrines to and from Branford.
- 2. Carefully remove upholstery and keep intact, ready for reupholstering.
- 3. Glue all loose joints, reset any blocking with hide glue.
- 4. Reassemble vitrines and perform neccessary repairs.
- 5. Clean existing finishes to chairs and couch also upper sections of vitrines. Refinish stripped legs to match.
- 6. Photograph work progression.

- 2. Carefully remove upholstery and keep intact, ready for reupholstering.
- 3. Glue all loose joints, reset any blocking with hide glue.
- 4. Reassemble vitrines and perform necessary repairs.
- Clean existing finishes to chairs and settee and upper sections of vitrines. Refinish stripped legs to match.
- Photograph work in progress.


Dear Lorraine.


