

Since the tea/coffee service was made by Tiffany & Co., and the trophy cup was made by Howard Silver Company, a less desirable manufacturer, I have lowered the per ounce value of the trophy cup to \$45/oz., as compared to the tea set @ \$53/oz.

$\$45/\text{oz.} \times 20 \text{ oz.} = \900 base value

However, added valuation, due to the Coe Hall-Coe Family provenance, has increased its final valuation significantly. Such a piece, in the "House-Museum" context becomes an important part of the overall perception and interpretation of the lifestyle of the Coe family.

Therefore, I have valued the fruit bowl/compote at \$75/oz. or \$1500.
