Description of Property:

One Chinese porcelain vase, *doucai* colored and mounted as a lamp on a cast bronze base, late 19th – early 20th century.

Measurements: vase 13" h. x 10" d.; 29" h. (overall)

One loving cup trophy, sterling silver in the Georgian style and inscribed to WRC's horse "Piping Hot, made in London 1895.

Measurements: 15 1/2" h. x 8" d.; 14" w.

One table centerpiece, four-footed with a turned-down repousse design rim, sterling silver and engraved "WRC", made by Tiffany c. 1900.

Measurements: 4 1/2" x 14 1/2" d.; 54 oz.

One circular serving tray, sterling silver Georgian style engraved "C", made by Gorham Company mid-20th century.

Measurements: 13 1/2" d.; 28 oz.

One Georgian Rococo coffee pot, sterling silver with repousse designs overall and a curved pear wood handle, made in London mid-18th century.

Measurements: 11" h.; 32 oz.

Parrot on a perch sculpture; sterling silver with removable head and hinged wings on a columnar perch, made in London 1905.

Measurements: 11" h.; 20 oz.

One Victorian claret jug, sterling silver with hinged lid and a circular base, mask of Bacchus at the base of the handle, made in London 1875.

Measurements: 13" h.; 32 oz.

One continental silver wine goblet, sterling silver with a square base and engraved in German, likely made in Prussia early 19th century.

Measurements: 7 1/2" h.; 12 oz.

One domed cover loving cup trophy, sterling silver in the Georgian style inscribed to WRC's horse "Laughing Queen", made in London by Crichton Bros. 1928.

Measurements: 10 ½" h.; 56 oz.

One circular candy dish, sterling silver with a chased floral design rim, made by Theodore B. Starr early 20th century.

Measurements: 6 oz.

One Thai covered bowl, sterling silver with a heavily repoussed overall design and Thai dancer finial, engraved "Mai 1920", made in Thailand early 20th century.

Measurements: 5 ½" h.; 9 oz.

One Irish domed cover loving cup trophy, sterling silver in the late Georgian style with foliate-gadrooned border and pineapple finial, possibly made by Joseph Jackson in Dublin 1779.

Measurements: 14 ½"; 54 oz.

Twelve footed shot cups, sterling silver with gilt interior and engraved "E.C.C. 1933 Trap-Shooting", made by Udall & Ballou early 20th century.

Measurements: 3 ¼" h.; 5 oz.

One dessert-serving spoon, sterling silver in the Baroque style with reticulated gilt bowl, made by Gorham Company c. 1900.

Measurements: 10 oz.

Two silver-deposit spirits decanters, glass with sterling silver in the Art Nouveau style, one is clear with a thistle motif and the other is amber with a rye motif.

Measurements: 12" h.

One sugar castor, sterling silver in the Colonial style and sold by the Metropolitan Museum in the late 20th century.

Measurements: 4 ¼" h.

One pepper shaker, sterling silver in the Georgian style with repoussed design and footed base, c. 1900.

Measurements: 5" h.

One Continental silver open salt, sterling silver and seashell shaped with a seated driver, the shell being drawn by a single reindeer, c. 1900.

Measurements: 2 ¼" x 4 ½"

One personal teapot, sterling silver in the Georgian style with a hinged lid and ivory handle spacers, engraved "CSC", mid-20th century.

Measurements: 4 ½" h.; 8 oz.

One English toast rack, silver plate and supported on four ball feet, early 20th century.

Measurements: 4 ½" x 5 ¼"

One egg-shaped covered server, silver plate in the Edwardian style with a Greek key surround and fluted bone finial, c. 1900.

Measurements: 9" h.

One circular glass serving tray, quadruple silver plate surround and clear glass bottom with two turned wood handles.

Measurements: 6" x 9 ½"

Six-piece tea and coffee service, silver plate and silver soldered in the Georgian Rococo style, lobed bodies with foliate-gadrooned edges and engraved "MRC". The set includes teapot, coffee pot, covered sugar bowl, covered waste bowl, creamer and hot water kettle. Made by Tiffany & Company early 20th century.

One framed photograph, black and white photograph of Clover, Bill and Mike Coe c. 1931, red painted wood frame with black interior edge and metal easel back.

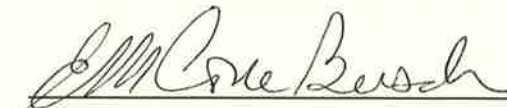
Measurements: 9 1/2" h. x 7 1/2" w. (overall)
