DOMINANT DESIGNS, ENGRAVINGS, DECORATIONS, COLORS, SHAPES, ETC.

Count cupboard of oak in a dull blackish brown finish. In two parts, two doors top and 3 doors bottom, wooden knob pulls. Prominent decorations are flat incised strapwork type carvings on frieze of top piece, frieze and stiles of lower section, and on five panels. Bullion pendants suspended from either end of top frieze. Enscribed "WMB 1672" on center of top section frieze.
