Conservation Comments:


William Clark: Not treated. Not original to house.


David Bayne: Interesting chairs and needs further investigation.

Exposed to high light levels and possible damage when door is opened similar to the table (see above). Stable and not a priority.



Monitor light levels and condition.






Director's Comments

Conservation Comments:

William Clark: Treated by Peter Arkell in Connecticut in early 1980's. Apparently cleaned with alcohol and reshellacked.

David Bayne: Appears stable. Note carving with out inlay or applied decoration may date this to either early part of 17th century or provincial manufacture.

Recommendations:

Find treatment records if they exist in files or possibly contact Arkell directly to see if he has copies.
