CLETUS. The name rings distinction and uniqueness.

Brother Cletus Behlmann, S.M., is a Marianist Brother, artist-in-residence, and director of the St. Mary's Art Center. He is, indeed, one of San Antonio's art treasures.

CLETUS, as he signs his work, is one of the Alamo City's most productive and imaginative artists. The subtleties of his varied works express a quiet, unassuming message, but in reality, CLETUS resounds in joyful, artistic inventiveness. The essence of his creations are the results of warm hues that convey the spirit of his many travels to foreign countries and the people he meets.

His artistic works are not limited to watercolor alone, the name CLETUS dons metal sculpture, acrylic, batik, ceramic, handmade paper, linoleum cut, serigraphy, collage, and stained glass. His expressions adorn homes and numerous chapels and religious settings. Among those locations are St. Mary's High School, St. Louis, Missouri, United Church of Christ, Orlando, Florida, Mount Carmel Convent, New Orleans, Louisiana, Taegu Air Force Base, Korea. And in San Antonio his creations are displayed at Coker Methodist Church, Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland Air Force Base, St. John Neuman Parish and other local churches.

Perhaps the most telling factor in Brother Cletus' work is his attitude about it. "It's not a job. It's something I love to do."
