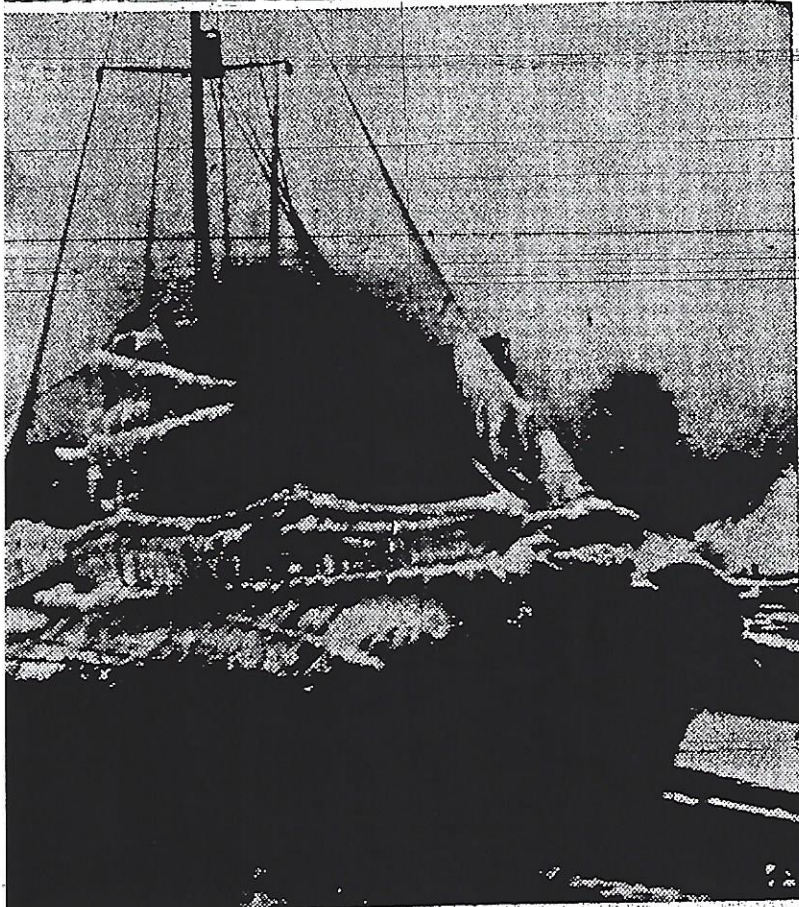


WINTER IS HERE, WHISKERS AND ALL
