

Know all Men by these Presents That I Eleazar Trevett, of Newport in the County of Newport and State of Rhode Island, Gentleman, in consideration of Eleven Hundred dollars paid me by Benedict Fenwick of Boston in the County of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, Bishop of Boston, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Benedict Fenwick, in Trust for the Roman Catholic Church in Newport, a certain lot of land, lying and being in said Newport, and Buttressed and Bounded as follows, viz: Southerly on Barney Street fifty feet, Easterly on land of Rev^r Caleb Greene one hundred feet, Northerly on land of Davis Simmons sixty feet, Westerly on the land formerly belonging to the Grammar Society, now the property of the Town Schools, one hundred feet, &c the same more or less, or however otherwise. Buttressed and Bounded, with the Buildings thereon standing, and all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, it being the same lot of land John Trevett bought of Caleb Greene, and sold to me the said Eleazar Trevett, for the purpose of building an Academy.

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid premises to the said Benedict Fenwick his Heirs and Assigns, to his and their Use and Benefit forever in Trust as aforesaid. And I for myself my heirs, executors and Administrators do covenant with the said Benedict Fenwick his and Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in Fee of the aforesaid Premises; That they are free of all Incumbrances; That I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Benedict Fenwick. And that I for myself my heirs, executors, and administrators, will Marrant and Defend the same Premises to the said Benedict Fenwick heirs and Assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In Witness Whereof I the said Eleazar Trevett have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eighth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight.
