S. S. Mary and Joseph's Cemetery.

RULE 1. The present portion of the Cemetery is laid out in sections, A. B. C. D. separated by avenues, St. Mary's and St. Joseph's, sixteen feet wide. Each section embraces forty eight lots measuring eight by sixteen feet.

RULE 2. The lots are sold at the following rates :—
For a whole lot, measuring eight by sixteen feet, Twenty doll's.
For a half lot, eight by eight feet, Twelve "
For two graves, four by eight feet, Eight "
For a single grave, two by eight feet, Five "
For the grave of a child under seven years of age Three "

RULE 3. The above stated prices are to be paid before any right is given. Those paying for single graves have the privilege of interring only one corpse therein.

RULE 4. Purchasers of a lot, half lot, or single grave, are to receive a receipt when payments are made, signed by the Pastor of the Church, at Newport, appointed by the Rt. Rev. Bishop of the diocess; which receipt shall entitle them to hold such lot, half lot, or single grave, as property, provided the conditions as expressed in rule seventh, hereinafter stated, be complied with.
