Identify Elder Man in Stonington

An Elderly man found wandering aimlessly in Stonington Borough late Saturday afternoon has been identified as Avide Desjarlais of 113 LehighStreet, Warwick, it was reported yesterday by Police Chief Charles A. Murphy of the Stonington Police Department.

Chief Murphy explained that a description of the man was sent over Westerly and Groton State police teletype systems Sunday. Mr. Desjarlais daughter reported him missing in Warwick and was directed by police in that city to Stonington. She came to police headquarters Monday night and identified the man as her father.

Desjarlais is reported to have left home following a family quarrel.

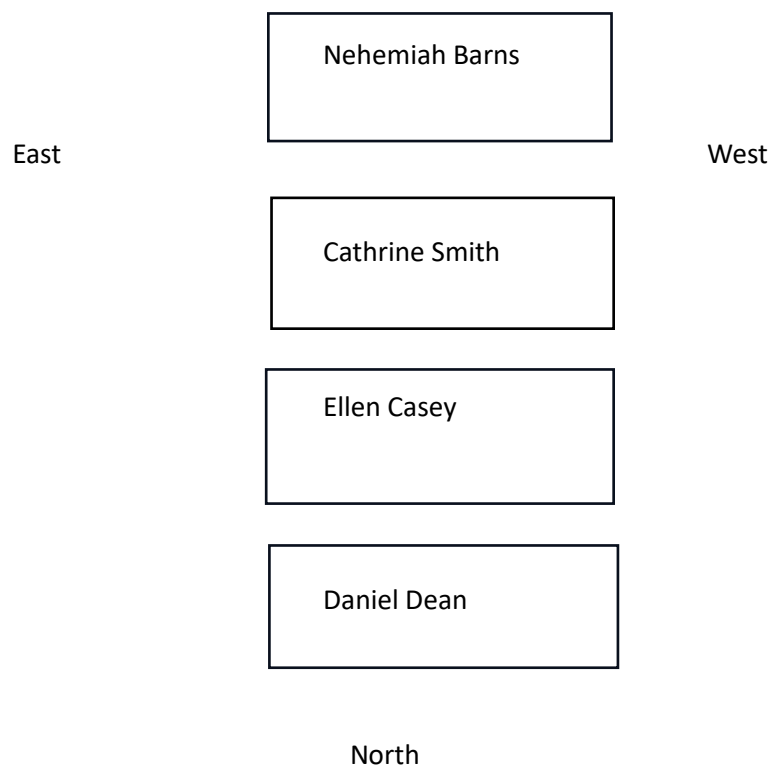

I had never been up in the Northern part of the state; so we drove to Frisco across the State and down through Bakersfield and home. Dorothy proved to be a good little trouble. She is growing us [sic] so fast. It's hard. To believer that only a few months ago she was a little babe and now she manovers [sic] around the play pen like an old timer.

Mrs. Friedman + Henry are well. They don't know when they will be East. We don't see them too often but talk to each other via phone. It is so nice for ----te have some one from home out here.
