My Dear Lieutenant:

You no doubt are aware from the newspaper stories released by the Executive Office that the State of Michigan has accepted the allocation of troops made it by the War Department and will begin reorganization in the not distant future of the following Michigan National Guard units: State Hqs and Hqs Det, Air Force Troops and 46th Division.

While Governor Kelly is most desirous that the reorganization of the National Guard be accomplished at the earliest possible date, he is likewise equally insistent that the Michigan State Troops continue as an effective organization until such time as the National Guard is organized and operating.

The armory facilities available to the State are limited, and to insure the accomplishment of the Governor's desires, the best of cooperation must exist between the officers and men of the State Troops and those officers engaged in reorganizing the Guard.

While both the State Troops and the Michigan National Guard are part of the Michigan Military Establishment and in the eyes of the State one and the same, certain policies covering age, physical, and professional qualifications prescribed by the Federal authorities for the National Guard of the United States, which in Michigan will consist of the National Guard of Michigan, make it impossible for all of us in the State Troops to enter the new organization.

The many of us who can meet the requirements must by all means signify our intentions to transfer to the Guard and those of us who cannot, must not only redouble our efforts to keep the State Troops up to their present high standard, but use all our influence to assist in bringing National Guard material into the State Troops for subsequent transfer to the new Guard organization.

The directive of our Chief Executive when translated into State Troop language means but one thing, we can be relieved from State Troop duty only after Michigan has its National Guard organized.

I understand the sacrifices that all of us are making in the interest of the State Troops, and further, I know many of you have been making such sacrifices over a period of five years; notwithstanding this, I am sure you realize that never at any time since their activation has there been a greater need for State Troops than there is today. If we fail to make the additional sacrifices that are still required, our former ones may have been in vain.


A copy of a letter from the Governor to some 5,000 former servicemen is inclosed for your information.

No doubt many of those who will receive this letter will contact you upon receipt of same. It is my hope, belief and my desire that you explain to them that the Governor wants those interested in joining the new Guard to signify such desire by enlisting in the State Troops as well as the Guard, thereby not only accomplishing their membership in the new Guard, but, at the same time, insuring the maintenance of the State Troops until sufficient enlistment in the Guard has been accomplished to justify their acceptance by the Federal Government as Troops of the National Guard of the United States.

During the camp period at Grayling a conference of the officers of each echelon will be held, during which the program of the Governor will be fully discussed.

In the interval between the receipt of this communication and the conference at Camp it is enjoined upon all officers of the State Troops to maintain the present strength of their organization and to fully cooperate in the Governor's plan of reorganization of the Guard.
