

This Indenture made this fift day of November
in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty between Walter P. Snow
of Worcester County in the State of Maryland, of the one part
and James B. Robins, of the same county, and State of the
other part, Whereas, by a decree of the Court of Chancery of
Maryland, dated on the 19th. day of May in the year
1849, and passed in a cause in the said court, between Ana
Spence and John P. Robins complainants, and Thomas A.
Spence, defendant, the above named Walter P. Snow, was ap-
pointed a trustee, with authority to sell the real estate
in the proceedings in said cause mentioned; and the
said trustee, after complying with all the previous requi-
sites of the decree did on or about the nineteenth day of
October, Eighteen hundred and forty nine sell unto the
said James B. Robins, the following parcels of said re-
al estate, and at the price following, that is to say, all
those tracts, parts of tracts or parcels of land, lying and being
situate in Worcester County, on the west side of Pocomoke river, cal-
led Gaerlavock, Leeds and Commons Gardens, being the same
lands heretofore conveyed by a certain Thomas A. Spence to
Ana Spence and John P. Robins, by a deed of mortgage dated
the first day of July 1845, bounded by the county road leading
from Snow Hill bridge to Justice Mr. Bratten's, the lands of Justice
Mr. Bratten and the Pocomoke river, by whatsoever name or
names the same may be known or called

as and for the sum of Four thousand and twenty five dol-
lars, current money.

And whereas the aforesaid sale hath been duly reported
to, and ratified and confirmed by the said Court of Chan-
cery, and the purchase money aforesaid, having been duly
paid and satisfied to the said Trustee, he is authorized
by the said decree to execute these presents. Now this in-
denture witnesseth that the said Walter P. Snow trustee
as aforesaid, for and in consideration of the premises
aforesaid, and of the sum of five dollars current money
to him in hand paid, by the said James B. Robins
at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath gra-
nted, bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released
and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bar-
gain and sell, alien, enfeoff release convey and con-
firm, unto the said James B. Robins his heirs and as-
signs, all the aforesaid lands and real estate

which are hereinbefore mentioned and described, as sold by the said Walter P. Snow, Trustee, to the said James B. Robins called barloversock, Leeds and Common Lands, or by whatever name or names the same may be known or called, with the appurtenances, and all the right title interest and estate of the parties to the aforesaid deed and every of them, both at law and in equity, in and to the same, and every part and parcel thereof.

To Have and To Hold the aforesaid lands and real estate, or premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said James B. Robins, his heirs and assigns, to his and their only proper use and behoof, and to and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Walter P. Snow hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first hereinbefore written.
