A true extract taken from the last will and
Testament of John Purnell Robins, late of Worcester
County, deceased, probated in the office of the Register
of Wills on the 1st day of December, 1780, and recorded
in Liber J. B. No 4. Folio 448, 450 & 451.

Item, I give and bequeath unto my son Littleton Robins all
the land I bought of John Emis, ^{Ed Lib. I, 214 Emis Addition 100 and} and one tract of
land joining said land called Robins Addition and
also part of the land where I now live, bounded as follows,
Beginning a gut running up said to a branch called
Hosliors Branch and from said branch a South
West Corer across to the road then up said road to
divisional line between my sister Mary and myself
and all the land lying to Northward of the said
division with the Mill unto him his heirs and
assigns forever,
