COVER STORY

Through the opening of "The Little Red School" as a special education center in September, 1957, Worcester County moved a small step closer to its goal of providing an adequate program of education for all of its children. This building, with its name, its red color, its bell tower, and its surrounding white board fence, will provide for many a nostalgic reminder of an institution which made a major contribution to the development of American education. In the renovation of the building for its present use, an attempt has been made to retain or re-create, in outward appearance at least, something of the character of its famous ancestor, suggesting, perhaps, the hope that the Little Red School may once again make possible an important development in our program of education.

In sharp contrast to the quaintness of the exterior treatment, every effort has been made to provide within the building facilities suited to the unique needs of the children to be educated there. Heating, ventilation, lighting, acoustics, and decoration meet the highest modern standards. A variety of carefully selected furnishings, ranging from a toy cart to a child-sized bathtub, has been provided. A special bus transports children to this center from all sections of the county.

In this setting, two teachers and a teachers' aide are now developing a program for sixteen of our children who, until now, have not been able to secure the education they needed in the regular school program. Similar programs are already in operation in five other schools in this county.
