

This Indenture, made this day of
in the year Registered Standard and
fifty two, between Littleton R. Purcell
of Worcester County, in the State of Maryland
of the one part, and John S. Moore of the County
and State aforesaid, of the other part—
Whereas by a decree, passed at the Honorable
John Spence, Circuit Judge, from the Eighth
Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland,
dated on the twenty eighth day of January
in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty
two, in a cause, between William S.
Moore and Mary Anne his wife, com-
plainants, and Edward & Michael B.
Gaskins, defendants, the above named
Littleton R. Purcell was appointed a trustee
with authority to sell the real estate
in the proceedings in said cause and
named in the said trustee, after com-
plying with all the provisions requisite
of the decree, did, on or about the
day of in the year Eighteen hundred
and fifty two, sell unto the said William
S. Moore the following parcels of said
real estate, and at the prices following,
that is to say, all that parcel of Land, or
lot of Ground, with a brick stone house
thereon, situated in the town of Lizard
Hill, in the County and State aforesaid,
bounded as followeth, to wit: Beginning
at the North west corner of Market and Rock
streets, thence by division of the Market Street
until it intersects the South west side of
lot of Ground, belonging to Ocean Lodge,

No 61 of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows
thence by and with said lot of ground, to
a lot belonging to the heirs of Wm Bishop
thence by and with said lot to Bank
street, thence by and with Bank street
to the first beginning, the same being
a part of lot Number
as designated on the plan of the town
of Snows Hill, at and for the sum of
one thousand and one dollars, current
money - And the said trustee did at the
same time sell unto the said J. H. Moore,
another parcel of lot or parcels
of land, lying and being in the County and
State aforesaid, known as the wharf prop-
erty, lying on the north east bank of
the Pocomoke River, at the foot of Snow
Hill bridge; bounded as follows: On
the North East, by the County road; on
the South by Pocomoke river, on the
West & North by the land of James B. Robin,
at and for the sum of one thousand
and thirty three dollars, current money.
And whereas, the aforesaid sale has been
duly reported to, and satisfied and confirm-
ed by the said Circuit Judge, for the eighth
judicial Circuit of Maryland; and the
purchase money aforesaid having been
fully paid and satisfied to the said
trustee, he is authorized by the said
decree to execute these presents - Now
this indenture witnesseth that the said
John R. Powell trustee as aforesaid
and his co-testate witness, and of the

premises aforesaid, and of the sum of
five dollars, current money, to him in
hand paid by the said William S Moore,
at and before the sealing and delivering of these
present, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged, hath granted bargained and
sold, aliened enfeoffed, released and con-
firmed, and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell, alien enfeoff release
and confirm unto the said W^m S Moore his
Moore his heirs & assigns, all the aforesaid
parcels of land or lots of Ground, which
are hereinbefore described as sold by
the said trustee to the said William S Moore
with their appurtenances, and all the right
title interest and estate of the parties to
the aforesaid decree, and every of them
both at law and in equity, in and to the same
and every part and parcel thereof. To have
and to hold the aforesaid parcels of land
or lots of Ground and premises, with their
appurtenances, unto the said William S Moore
his heirs and assigns, to his and their only
proper use and behoof, and to no other
use, intent or purpose whatsoever. In witness
