The Public Works Administration of our Federal Government has made it possible for Pocomoke City to erect the new Fire Engine House which is being dedicated today.

The Building is ideally arranged and sufficient in size to serve the community for many years to come. The first floor provides space for the fire-fighting apparatus; recreation room, toilets and showers. The second floor has a large auditorium, lounge room, bed room and bath, ladies powder room and toilet, also one of the most modern and best equipped kitchens in the State of Maryland.

The cost of the Building, including kitchen and furniture equipment, is \$50,909.00, which was shared by the Public Works Administration and the City on a basis of 45% and 55%, respectively. Its completion and dedication will long be a source of pride and gratification to the people of Pocomoke City.
