

The State of Maryland To all persons to whom these presents shall come Greeting, Know Ye That for and in
consideration that Leonard Johnson of the County of Worcester hath due unto him eighteen acres of Land by virtue of
a Warrant for that quantity granted out of the Proprietarys Land (Wee), according to the Conditions of Plantation
then in force, the sixteenth day of May seventeen hundred and seventy two as appears, and the right of the said
Proprietary being now vested in the State of Maryland, The said State doth hereby grant unto him the said Leonard
Johnson all that Tract or Parcel of Land called Puzzle situate lying and being in the County aforesaid bounded and
described as followeth. Beginning for this Survey at a marked Red Oak standing near the North Corner of a Tract
of Land called Purgatory now in the Possession of John Johnson lies about one mile and a half from the Bay
side thence running North thirty seven degrees West fifteen Perches thence North East two hundred Perches
thence South thirty seven degrees East fifteen Perches thence with right Line to the first Beginning containing
and now laid out eighteen acres of Land more or less, according to the Certificate of Survey thereof taken and
returned into said Office bearing date the second day of August seventeen hundred and seventy two and there
remaining. To have and to hold the same unto him the said Leonard Johnson his Heirs and Assigns forever. Given under the
Great Seal of the State of Maryland this eleventh day of October seventeen hundred and eighty two.
