'02, Apr. 12th. Surveying for cousin J. B. R.
Begin at W. corner of Colaveric, thence S. 47° W.
by and with Mr. Bratten's road 37 $\frac{7}{10}$ ch. To
Bratten's line, thence by & with the same
S. 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. (62 ch. to pine thicket,) 71 ch. to marked
pine at river swamp, thence (after borrow-
ing back on 2nd. line 7 ch.) by & with a road
along a fence, S. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 43 ch. to S.W. side of
Leeds, thence with Leeds S. 47 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 10 ch. to Swamp,
(thence back to Cherry Stump is 18 $\frac{7}{10}$ ch.)

Begin at end of 2nd. course on previous page, ^{that is paragraph}
^{that is at end of 71 ch.} thence N. 81° E. 6 ch. to crossing of gully, thence
S. 33° E. 22 ch. to Swamp, thence N. 54 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. 20 ch., thence
N. 47 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ch. to East gate post at wharf, (thence
N. 1 ch. to 1st B. of Colaveric,) thence ^{N.} 92° to
west side of Woods, ^{thence, in a right line to end of the 62 ch. run on} S. 69° W. 95 ch. ~~to Cypress~~
previous page (paragraph) thence to end of said 2nd line for pine woods.

From 1st B. of Colaveric to old Cypress near
weir is south 68 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. Fr- Cypress at wharf
to old Cypress = S. 78° E.

Begin at mark Cypress on wharf, thence
N. 37° at 10 ch. to 1st B. of Colaveric, thence back
on said line 1 ch. $\frac{1}{2}$ along edge of high
ground N. 48 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. (20 ch.) thence to old Cypress
S. 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 75 $\frac{4}{5}$ ch. to County road (thence to 2nd B.
Colaveric is N. 29 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 8 $\frac{1}{3}$ ch.) thence S. 29 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. from

Colaverie's ~~2nd~~ 2nd B, 45 ch to flat, 53 ch to
W^m S. Moore's wharf and 58 $\frac{1}{10}$ ch to west side of
Snow Hill bridge st. in a right line to old cypress
near ~~river~~ weir.

Begin at W. cor. of Colar, at M. Bratten's road,
th. S. $46\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E $47\frac{4}{5}$ ch to turn of road from house to pine
thicket + to 1st B of Colar. 214 p + to outside of
field fence ^{218 p} + to gate post $\frac{2}{5}$ p. distant.
From said turn of road N. $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. $16\frac{1}{2}$ ch. to gate at
corner of orchard (+ from said gate across to Eli Clayville
B. at turn of county road is N. $51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W.) continue
N. $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E from said turn of road 39 ch to end of
fence near stable, (and said fence runs S. $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.
to swamp.) continue N. $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 150 p to front gate
by road. From W. corner of Colar. to Eli Clayville
B. is N. $44\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. $14\frac{1}{5}$ ch. A ch. equals 2 poles.

The above seems to have been intended only
to make a diagram of the farm. I do not
think that any attempt was made to locate
boundary lines exactly. My recollection
is that we had not the papers requisite.
