

A **loan exhibition** is a temporary art exhibition where artworks are borrowed from collectors, museums, or galleries for public display. These exhibitions allow institutions to showcase rare or significant pieces they might not own, offering visitors a unique opportunity to see works that are usually kept in private collections or other museums¹.

Loan exhibitions can be themed around a particular artist, movement, or historical period, and they often require careful planning, including insurance, transportation, and agreements between lenders and borrowers
