1. 1899 - 1910 (part of 1911)	Book is stamped: Department of Public Instruction State of California Benicia District Library - Solano County Book contains listings of students by grade, ("High School" down to 4th grade) with the books they checked out and returned. Numbers were used instead of book titles. Some teacher names were listed but mostly just grade levels were noted.
2. as early at 1893-94 to 1908-09	Book is stamped: same as Ledger #1. Library books are listed by categories. Each book was assigned a number. This might be used to identify books read by students as listed in Ledger #1.
3. Sept. 1904 - Sept. 1909	This ledger contains the minutes of the meetings of the Benicia High School Lyceum. The book was donated to the club by Humphrey Lynch.
