

\$10,000 at euchre, at \$500 a game.

In San Francisco a new frame building has been erected on the lot opposite the Parker house, to be used as a drinking and sporting house, and the rent of which is to be \$6,000 per month, or \$200 per day.

Among the enterprises of the town is a large theatre about being erected, by Wm. A. Buffam, Esq.

A frame building belonging to Messrs Ross, Benton & Co., 25 by 43 feet, rented for \$16,000 per annum. A tent near Parker's Hotel rents for \$100 per day. A gambling shop sold for \$40,000 cash. Parker's Hotel brings altogether -- exchange offices, grog shops, gambling shyps, &c., over \$500,000 per annum. Labor \$16 to \$25 per day. Carting \$3 to \$5 per load.
