

Wassmann Letter 2

Seattle Wash Dec 30 1892

Dear Louise,

I received your letter, many thanks for the pin you sent me, it is very nice. I can't write you much more about Aunt, they went to Court on 27 Dec., and I haven't yet heard how it went. Aunt writes that Uncle does nothing but drink, if Aunt would only let herself be convinced to leave Portland that would be the best thing that she could do. Aunt wrote that he had lent out all the money that they had left in the bank. I don't even like to think about what a life they are leading. I want to write to Aunt tonight to see how everything went. I wish you a Happy New Year.
