Union Army 11/10/1863 - 10/26/1865

Protestant Episcopal minister, a graduate of the University of Michigan and the Auburn Theological Seminary. His pastorates included Terre Haute, Indiana, Beaufort, North Carolina, Kansas City, Missouri, and Baltimore, Maryland. He was the author of "The Principles of Church History Adapted to the Young", published by H.P. Durant in 1869.

Son of Jacobus or David Van Antwerp and Finella Patison. Married Jane Caroline Faxon, 08 Nov 1851. Their first two children were born in Terre Haute, IN, and their last three in Beaufort, SC. Jane died in New York, NY on 29 Dec 1901 and was buried in Prince George's County, MD.
