

DEATH'S SUMMONS.

Mrs. H. W. Jones, a Solano Pioneer, Passes Away in Benicia.

Harriet Wetmore Jones, wife of the late John Wesley Jones of Benicia, died on the 14th of this month, after a brief illness, at the age of 78 years.

This most estimable Christian woman, one of the few surviving of Benicia's earliest inhabitants, was born in Middletown, Conn., April 15, 1823, at the ancestral home of the Wetmore family. She was given the best education of her time, and lived with her parents until her marriage on the 8th of June, 1852. She accompanied her husband to California in the year 1855, and has resided continuously in this city ever since their arrival on this coast. Her husband died in Benicia November 14, 1897, and is buried beside their infant daughter Bertha, in the cemetery overlooking Carquinez Straits.—New Era.
