On the settlement of the account of Captain F.D. Callender, of Ordnance, for disbursements at Benicia Arsenal, for the third quarter of 1857, the 2nd Comptroller confirmed a balance due by him to the United States of \$20,081.41 differing from his account \$6,297.70 which the statement of difference enclosed will show. By an examination of the enclosed statement, it is manifest that proper care and attention in preparing the vouchers is not given by Captain Callender, nor does he seem to notice suspensions heretofore made in his accounts.
