THE HASTINGS WILL.

It Is Read Before Judge
Coffey.

An Estate Valued at Nearly
\$200,000.

Left to the Catherwood and Dio
Hastings' Children — The
Trust Deeds.

The will of the late S. C. Hastings was opened and read yesterday in the chambers of the probate department of the Superior Court. The persons present in the Judge's chambers at the time were William Giselman, trustee under the provisions of certain trust deeds long ago executed by the deceased; Ryland B. Wallace, who, with Mr. Giselman, is named as executor in the will; August E. Knust, brother of Mrs. Hastings; George A. Knight, who was exercising a watch on the interests of the widow; L. M. Hoefler of the law firm of Garber, Bealt & Bishop, who are attorneys for Mary C. Hastings, widow of the ex-Judge's deceased son, Robert P. Hastings, general guardian of her minor children, beneficiaries under the trust, and Alexander Z. Loughborough, in the interest of Azalea Keyes, a granddaughter.

The original will was in the deceased's own handwriting and was dated at San Diego, January 23, 1891. To it were attached codicils, three in number, all written by the testator, and bearing date respectively April 3, 1891, July 4, 1891, and November 2, 1891.
