

ANN ARBOR COMMENCEMENT.

Judge McKinstry Given an Honorary Degree.

ANN ARBOR (Mich.), June 27.—This was commencement day at the Michigan University. There were 438 graduates, 115 of whom took degrees in the literary department. Yeijero Ono, a Japanese, took the highest honors of the class. Honorary LL. D. degrees were conferred upon Chief-Justice Horton of the Supreme Court of Kansas, Professor E. M. McKinstry of the Hastings College of Law, San Francisco, and Rev. M. L. D. Oage of Ann Arbor.
