

## PREACHER'S ODD DYING REQUESTS

When the Rev. Edward Powers Gray died some days ago it was found that he had made arrangements to have his dust returned to dust with little delay. In his will he directed that his body should be placed in a plain pine casket and buried "in contact with the earth, without masonry or woodwork, but with some fragrant hay or clean straw upon it." He also asked that those who assumed mourning in his memory should wear something white, as a token that a Christian hope was commingled with their sorrow.
