Monterey Redoubt

August 25th 1854

Sir

I have received your letter enclosing a draft for thirty six dollars (\$36) in favor of Corpl Seymour for stage hire for himself and party from San Francisco to Monterey.

I am requested by Seymour to ask you if his account for board and subsistence on the road, for self and party, (forwarded at same time with account for stage hire) cannot be allowed.
