Vallejo Aug 4th 1856

Dear Bro

I expected to have been in to see you last week but Mr Miller being absent prevented me. I have written Robert Hubbard respecting a note which he left in your hands due I believe at this time. The contingency of these dull times continuing was spoken of between us and arranged for in case I could not conveniently meet it at the precise time. I thought until about ten days past that I could meet it but the times grow worse and worse here and money harder and harder to be got. When congress adjourns, which perhaps has already happened we shall expect to hear news from Washington that will set things moving here and make money matters easier.
