

## Golden Gate Mine.

We learn, says the *Benicia Tribune*, from Mr. H. G. Wetmore, who has just returned from the Golden Gate Mine, that its prospects are quite flattering. During the last two months shafts have been sunk and drifts run developing a fine paying body of ore of at least 5,000 tons. He says from the results obtained from the workings of the ore from the shafts and drifts, that the company can safely calculate upon \$45,000 from the ore in sight; and that with the addition of five stamps to their mill, this body of ore can be worked out in one at an expense of about \$20,000. He thinks stock in Golden Gate is better than a sheep ranch in the wilds of Colorado.
