

St. Peter's Day at Nashotah.

The observance of St. Peter's Day at Nashotah Theological Seminary, was one of unusual interest, the occasion being the ordination of the recent graduates to the ministry. At the appointed hour for services, the pleasant little chapel was crowded to its utmost with the congregation gathered to witness the impressive ceremony. The church had been tastily decorated with evergreens and flowers, and a beautiful arch encircled the chancel. Noted clergy from abroad present were Bishop Welles, of Wisconsin; Bishop Brown, of Fond du Lac; Bishop Gillespie, of Illinois; Bishop Talbot, of Indiana; Bishop Robertson, of Missouri; Revs. Dr. Spaulding, of Milwaukee; W. F. Lloyd, of Warsaw; Cooper, of Japan; Harrington, of Indiana; Tate and Lance; Dr. Shelton, Jewell, Cole, Adams and Eggar, of Nashotah. Music for the occasion by the Nashotah choir, was an interesting feature, Prof. Moran presiding at the organ. Bishop Robertson, of Missouri, preached an able doctrinal discourse, pronounced in a pleasing and entertaining manner. The students ordained were as follows: Messrs. Cressey and Sheridan, of Mass., ordained deacons; John McKim, of Ill., and S. Rucker, of Ohio, advanced to the priesthood. Mr. J. Prosser, of Michigan, one of the recent graduates, is to be ordained at his home next Sunday.

In the evening, services were held at St. John Chrysostom's Church, in Delafield, attended by the visiting clergy. Bishop Gillespie preached the sermon. A memorial cross was presented in memory of the late Dr. DeKoven, by Messrs. Bevington and Wilkinson.
