My dear Captain,

Yours of yesterday is rec'dy Herewith I enclose to you various letter copies which ought to be in the Arsenal letter book.

The reason why the caps were not sent is not Stated in any that I have copies of, but was in a letter to the Governor of Oregon as you will see. We all supposed Caps would have been out long since to fill the Enormous territorial requisitions.

If Col Riley thinks it necessary I can purchase any quantity here for you at about \$6 per probably \$5.

Will you be kind Enough to send down per Express, my sword & belt which are in your quarters. Did the Shoes fit? I turned over money to you audits long since at the Asst _____ but have not called for receipts as I expected to see you down here.

Please come down when you can make it Convenient to do so.
