

Peter G. Aguayo was born in 1886 in West Covina Township. He was the 5th of 14 children of Ignacio and Ramona Rodriguez Aguayo. Ignacio's brother Gabriel and Ramona's mother, Placida Ruelas (of John Turner) were both homesteaders in the San Gabriel Valley. Before that they were early settlers on the Rancho Azusa. I knew little of this uncle other than he changed his name to Peter Gray and moved to Oakland. Later I learned from my father Peter had a bike shop. Only very recently did I learn the following:

- 1) NOV 11, 1912 - Adjudication of Bankruptcy filed in the District Court of Southern California

2) card index at L.A. Public Library leading to a San Dimas community directory for 1911 showing Pete's advertisement for his shop

3) Images of America, Azusa - a photo of Peter on a bike with brother Joe and cousins

4) - a birth record for a son, Alfred O. Aguayo born Dec 3, 1909, in Los Angeles; son was in the Navy in 1936 in San Francisco
