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knowledge of their undertakings and also in a large measure to the affable personalities with which both are fortunately endowed.

### **F. H. McCurry**

F. H. McCurry, one of the largest citrus growers in this area and a very prominent Mason, is a native of El Paso, Texas, born January 20, 1909, son of Henry and Anna McCurry. He first attended school in his native city, but most of his education was in Los Angeles, as he came to that city with his parents in 1908, and prior to coming to the Pomona Valley lived most of his life in the area of Manchester Boulevard and Broadway.

Mr. McCurry married Miss Mildred Richter, and they have lived in the Pomona Valley some sixteen years, having come here in 1934. The home place is a large residence on a twenty-five acre grove fronting on Foothill Boulevard in the La Verne section. In addition to this property, seventy acres of citrus are owned in San Dimas, another ten acres in Claremont and a hundred and ten acres in Alta Loma.

Mr. McCurry's Masonic activities include the Blue Lodge in San Dimas; Pomona Chapter, R. A. M. (Past High Priest); Pomona Commandery (Past Commander); Al Malaikah Shrine Temple of Los Angeles; and Old Baldy Shrine Club.

Mr. McCurry is a Director of the La Verne Cooperative Citrus Association, and he is a former member of the Board of the San Dimas Water Company.

Mrs. McCurry was formerly from Corona. Her two children by her first marriage, Ernest and Beverly, were adopted by Mr. McCurry and took his name.

### **Howard H. Fetterling**

Howard H. Fetterling is an example of a man who has made a splendid success in the real estate business in a comparatively short time. In 1946, he passed the examination for real estate broker, and became connected with the well-known firm of Booth Brothers.
