Teague Families

Crossed the 'great plains' by wagon, being six months enroute in 1865. Settled first in Santa Rose. Came to San Dimas in 1878. In 1888 planted the first oranges — lost the first crop to great windstorm of 1891. Robert M. started nursery in 1889 when he was 26 years old.
