

Permit to build fish weirs.

W, Geo. F. Taft, T. R. Hammond and R. D. Guptill, Municipal Officers of the town of Gouldsboro, by virtue of authority vested in us by law, upon the application of Daniel Deasy to build fish weirs at Indian Harbor, at east and west end of bar that extends from inner Bar Island, so called, to the opposite shore on Crowley Island, so called, in said Town of Gouldsboro. After giving the notice therefor and after giving a hearing at Indian Harbor on 12th day of January 1895 at Tabbuts store in the matter and hearing no objection made, do hereby grant this permit to build said fish weirs as above described.
