Notice is hereby given that the Selectmen will be in session at the Town Office, Pond Road on Saturday, May 14 at 2 o'clock to act upon the application of Fulton Backman to build, extend and maintain a fish weir in the waters of Frenchman's Bay, to wit:

Said weir to be located about 500 feet to the South of Stave Island having a round catch pound about 600 feet in diameter, a pocket about 40 by 80 feet and two leaders extending about 200 feet each in a southwesterly and a southeasterly direction.


Let all interested persons govern themselves accordingly.
